- Sturdy Carrier
- Spray bottle to prevent over heating in summer months
- Blanket to cover cage for winter months
- Catch net
- Paper towels to line/clean cage
- Toys
- Proper Cleaning Supplies
- Garbage Bags
- Flashlight & Batteries
- Photo of you and your pet
- Lost Pet Flyer – have it already created in case your pet gets lost
